- ✓ **Scholarship Category A (non EU students):** € 47.000 for 2 years
- ✓ **Scholarship Category B :** € 34.000 for 2 years with mandatory specialty residency.

Educational Program :

TPTI is the acronym for Industrial Technology, Heritage and Territories. TPTI offers a two-year high quality educational program, and is designed for students or professionals wishing to develop a comprehensive (methodological, theoretical and practical) approach for the investigation and value enhancement of industrial and cultural heritage. The focus of the master program is historical analysis leading to an in -depth analysis and value enhancement of industrial sites. It provides its students with scientific knowledge acquired through research and practice.

INTERNATIONAL: residencies in universities (France, Italy, Portugal) + specialty mobility residency (Spain, Tunisia, Czech Republic, Brazil)

INTERSECTORAL: research and professional training (internship and mandatory site visits) offer 3 specialties (history of technology, conservation and didactics of industrial heritage, technical heritage and cultural landscape: management and value enhancement) and 1 additional specialty at choice (heritage and economics of cultural property; tourism, archaeology and development; history of technology and contemporary technology - work, mediation and culture, sustainability).

TPTI Diploma

- ✓ **A Joint Diploma :** The students of the TPTI Master Program are awarded a multiple diploma , which consists of in three different diplomas given by the three partner universities. In addition they are awarded a diploma supplement. After their two years of study, graduates will receive the following credentials:
 - Master of the History of Science and History of Technology, University of Paris 1 Pantheon-Sorbonne.
 - Master of Management and Value Enhancement of Historical and Cultural Heritage, Department of History, University of Evora.
 - Master of Historical Science. Curriculum: Industrial Technology, Heritage and Territories, University of Padua.
- ✓ **The Diploma Supplement :** Graduates from European and non-European countries will also receive a special supplement to the TPTI master diploma, the Diploma Supplement. Based on the Europass model it explains in English the different modules completed by the students in each university and it keeps a detailed record of the student's performance in coursework, field study and internship activities, as well as the thesis and specialized domain.

Career Opportunities

Working or studying with a TPTI Diploma

Students may pursue their studies at doctoral level (the TPTI Consortium offers a PhD Program in applied history, HERITECHS), in which case they need a minimum grade of 16/20 for the master degree. They may also take positions in public institutions and private organizations (museums, inventories, collections related to industrial and technical archaeology); they may work as cultural mediators and consultants (supporting museum design projects or management and development of monumental sites and structures; designing cultural routes and itineraries for industrial tourism); they may as well choose to work in the field of communication (scientific and technical journalism)
